## FACTS AT A GLANCE

**AREA:** County, 563 sq. miles; Rutherfordton, 2.6 sq. miles; Spindale, 4.62 sq. miles; Forest City, 10.6 sq. miles. The county is composed of eight municipalities: Bostic, Chimney Rock, Ellenboro, Forest City, Rutherfordton, Ruth, Spindale and Lake Lure. Connected by US Hwy 74-Business, Rutherfordton, Spindale, and Forest City form the Tri- City area. The towns of Lake Lure and Chimney Rock are located approximately 20 miles west of Rutherfordton. Lake Lure is a private lake with public access.

**ELEVATION:** Rutherfordton, 1075 ft.; Spindale, 960 ft.; Forest City, 860 ft. County's lowest elevation - Caroleen, 806. County's highest elevation - Sugar Loaf, 3,967 ft.

**CLIMATE:** Average annual temperature, 59.9 F; average rainfall, 49.91 inches. Rainfall is concentrated in Spring and Fall. Average humidity, approximately 65%. Located in the Isothermal Belt, there are 200 frost-free days in the growing season. Average snowfall, 2.74 inches.

**EMPLOYMENT:** Rutherford county workforce totals 22,790 (2006 report). It breaks down as follows: manufacturing, 18.2 %; construction, 5.5%; transportation and utilities, 21.4%; education and health services, 24%; professional and business services, 9.3%; leisure and hospitality, 8.4%; information, 4%; financial activities, 2%; public administration, 5.3% and all other, 2.08%.

**RELIGION:** Most major religions are active in the county or in nearby communities.

**SCHOOLS:** North Carolina requires all children ages 7 to 16 to attend school. Students must present a vaccination certificate, birth certificate, and medical examination form upon entering kindergarten or first grade. In addition to the public schools, Rutherford County has five private schools (K-8) and one charter school. For more information on the public school system call (828) 245-0252. Isothermal Community College offers a variety of courses and activities to county residents. Whether you are looking to obtain a two or four-year degree, ICC can meet your educational needs. ## Points of Interest



**Chimney Rock Park** - A state park that encompasses 1,000 acres. The park is open year-round and offers hiking trails, waterfalls, and a 75 mile view. Chimney Rock Park was host to various scenes in the film “The Last of the Mohicans.”

**Lake Lure** - A 1,500 acre private lake with 27 miles of shoreline, a public beach access, and a magnificent view of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Boat tours are available April through November. Scenes from the film “Dirty Dancing” and “My Fellow American” were shot on and around the lake.

**Green River Plantation** - Public tours are available. The mansion is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

**St. John’s Church** - Built in 1846, this Trinity Lutheran Church is now the home of the Rutherford County Historical Society. It is also the oldest original church structure in Rutherford County.

**Bechtler’s Mint** - In operation from 1810 to 1849, it produced \$750,000 of gold per year and the nation’s first gold dollar.

**Farm Museum** - Learn about equipment that was used on Rutherford County farms and in the home decades ago.

**KidSenses**—A Children’s interactive museum. “The Sense of Wonder”, Children and adults are given a unique opportunity to play, learn and create together.

**Art Museum** - Displays of ancient and modern art.

**MaimyEtta Black Fine Arts Museum** - Displays art and historical records of Afro-Americans.

**Genealogical Library** - Houses and preserves genealogical and historical records of Old Tryon County and the surrounding area.

**Globe Theater** - Come to the visitor’s center and learn about the only replica of Shakespeare’s Globe Theater in North Carolina.

**Tanner Factory Outlet Stores** - Three stores offer a broad selection of classic women’s clothing and fabric.

**Brittain Church** - The oldest church west of the Catawba River in North Carolina.

**Pumpkin Center** - Offers a variety of pumpkins for the holidays, September through November.

## Geography

Rutherford County is situated in the foothills of Western North Carolina centered between Asheville and Charlotte. The new US Hwy 74 connector between I-26 and I-85 serves as a corridor to and from these regional centers of commerce. US Highways 64 and 221 provide easy access to I-40 and I-85.

**Asheville** - 55 miles northwest via Hwy 221N to I-40W or Hwy 74W to I-26W.

**Charlotte** - 70 miles southeast via Hwy 74E to I-85N.

**Hickory** - 60 miles northeast via Hwy 64E to I-40 east

**Spartanburg, SC** - 35 miles southeast via Hwy 221S to I-85S or Hwy 74W to I-26E.

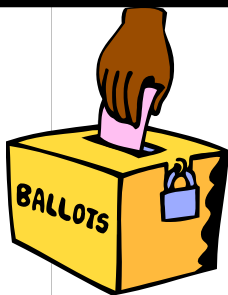

## Board of Elections



You may join the ranks of 37,000 other registered voters in Rutherford County by visiting the county Board of Elections or calling to receive a mail-in voter registration form.

The forms will require you to attest to your citizenship, full name, date of birth, address, and that you do not have any felony convictions that would keep you from being eligible to vote

**General Information**

**Auto Registration** - Within twenty days of establishing permanent residence in North Carolina, motor vehicles must be registered. Vehicles must be state inspected within ten days following registration and must display a valid inspection sticker. Many service stations will perform this inspection. For more information contact (828) 248-1121 (you will get an answering machine, indicate you have a question and hold on).

**Driver's License** - A North Carolina driver's license is required within thirty days after residence has been established. Applicants under age eighteen are required to complete a driver's education course before securing a driver's permit or license. If a driver's education course was completed in another state, this may be accepted. Handbooks, driver's permits, and licenses may be obtained Monday through Friday at the Driver's License Examiner's office on Withrow Road, Spindale, NC between the hours of 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. For more information contact (828) 286-2973.

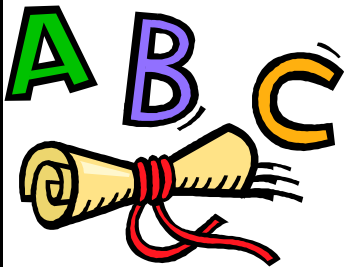

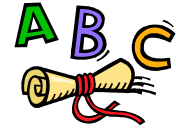
